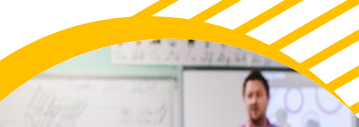
Autumn Break @ KERIC

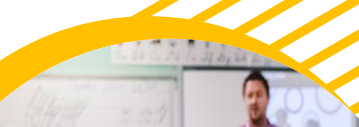
Europe & Us @KERIC
